CURRICULUM

BVMCC Alif Lam Meem School

Recitation of the Qur'an: The objective is to help students read the Qur'an (not learn the Arabic language). This however requires very active follow-up by parents at home.

Memorization of Surahs: Depends on the level of the student. Beginners will start with memorizing Juz' 30, advanced students will memorize different verses and Surahs such as: Ayat Al-kursi, Surat Al-mulk, Al-waqi'aa, Surat Yaseen ... (Audio CDs will be provided for this purpose)

For the young: In addition to Qur'an memorization, students will be taught some Islamic manners, stories from the Qur'an and basic Fiqh.

SCHEDULE

Classes will begin the first Monday of September at the BVMCC.

Classes for young students:

Class 1: Monday Between Asr and Maghrib Prayers & Sunday 9:00am to 10:30am

Class 2: Wednesday Between Asr and Maghrib Prayers & Sunday 10:30am to 12:00noon

Classes for adults:

For Brothers: Sunday 7:00 am – 9:00 am

For Sisters: Monday 10:30 am – 12:30 pm

Classes will be designed based on levels and age.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Dress code: All students are required to wear proper Islamic clothing. Clothing must be loose fitting. For girls, ankle-length skirts, long-sleeve shirts and headscarves that cover all their hair are required.

Students are expected to come to every class session on time with all assignments completed, and with their Qur'an, notebook and a pencil.

Parents should be prepared to actively work with their children to make sure the verses are memorized before the next class.
